RAGGING IS A PUNISHABLE OFFENCE

This Includes:

- a) Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- b) Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/ fellowship and other benefits.
- c) Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or other evaluation process.
- d) Withholding results.
- e) Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- f) Suspension/ expulsion from the hostel.
- g) Cancellation of admission.
- h) Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters or equivalent period.
- i) Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.

Note: Where the persons committing or abetting the act of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.

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What Constitutes Ragging?

Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts:

- a) Any conduct by any student or student's weather by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.
- b) Indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension there of any fresher or any other student.
- c) Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course so and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student.
- d) Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturb the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.
- e) Exploiting the service of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of student.
- f) Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students.
- g) Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping forcing obscene and lewd acts or any other danger to health or person;

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
